# EU Projects Design & Writing Training



### **Scenario**

Building on our project design and management experience, we aim at building the capacities of **GWMH stakeholders** to carry out their social initiatives by providing them with the needed skills to design and write **EU-funded projects** proposals.

Tree and GWMH organise together this training.

We make individuals & organisations autonomous. We also strengthen their competences, their social impact and their financial viability.

The **Erasmus+** funding programme is the framework for our training.



## **Our Approach**

#### 1. Mentoring

Our professionals have a robust experience in designing and writing social projects, hence, they know the challenges of a project development. This enables them to coach the participants in their learning process. Tailored mentoring is key for the success of the training. We only allow 5/6 people per training no less, no more

#### 2. Empowerment

Capacitating the participants to acquire the skills needed for designing and writing a concrete project, thereby making them autonomous for future projects

#### 3. Validation

The participants will be called to design a project (the project concept of 2 pages), which will allow them to verify the soundness of their ideas and ability to approach potential project partners. Then they will create the **project abstract of 10 pages** (workplan, indicators, partners, budget).

- Ensures that the design, development and writing of your projects is fully in line with your vision and mission – what matters is your project and not the EU call
- Gives you the possibility to create a committed and inspired EU projects team within your organisation
- Gives you a clear and comprehensive view of all available EU funding programmes

## The Methodology

- Development of a holistic approach to project design, where quality prevail over quantity
- Interaction between participants to stimulate creativity, also through the use of collaborative online tools
- Writing labs in smaller groups to increase engagement and active participation
- Access to specific templates (abstract, budget, logical chain, etc.)
   created by tree to facilitate the design and writing process
- Support during the preparation of the project and of the proposal, with timely collective writing sessions, access to successful writing examples and periodical evaluations and reviews
